

Doctor Harisingh Gour Vishwavidyalaya, formerly known as University of Saugar, Sagar was founded by Sir Doctor Harisingh Gour on 18th July 1946. University was upgraded as Central University by act of Parliament on 15th January 2009. This university is the 16th oldest University of country and the first university of Central province.
